

NATURAL HAIR COLOUR

The Cortex contains all the colour pigments in the hair. These are called Melanin.

Melanin is broken down into two types of colour pigments:-

- Black/Brown are called Eumelanin which are cool tones – Ash
- Red/Yellow are called Pheomelanin which are warm tones – Copper / Gold

The darker the hair, the more Eumelanin the hair structure contains.

The lighter the hair, the more Pheomelanin the hair structure contains.
